➤ Core Components of Cultural Kaleidoscope HHW

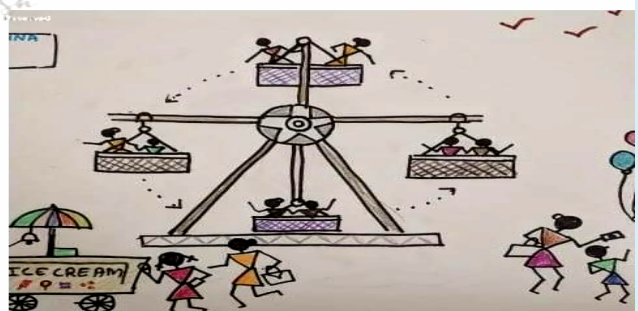
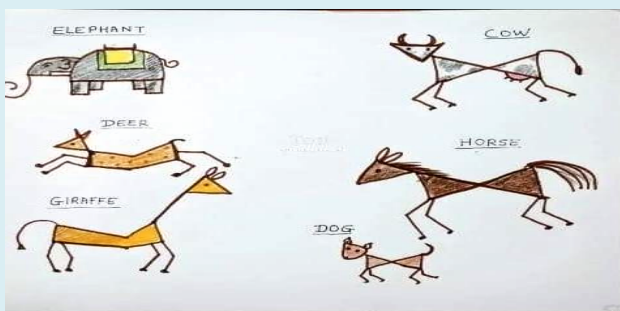
- Art & Craft: Creating collages, traditional paintings, or modeling traditional artifacts.
- Cultural Study: Researching traditional costumes, food, music, and dance from different regions.
- Heritage Awareness: Exploring famous monuments.
- Literature & Folklore: Writing or reviewing stories & folklores.



- **Culinary Map:** Draw a map and stick pictures of regional spices.



- **Folk Art Fusion:** Paint a traditional design (e.g., Madhubani or Warli) on a small terracotta pot or paper plate.



- **Fabric Craft** : Collect different waste fabrics and showcase your creativity through a craft (e.g., Purse, Tree, Pouch, Frame, Toy).



- **Folk Dance**: Create a short 30-45 seconds dance video/reel with your family/friends depicting any one state. Share the video/reel with your class teacher.
